

Capercaillie and black grouse

Hunting with pointing dog

*W*hen the season begins we hunt with pointing dogs. The birds sit on the ground and eat berries and grass. The dog searches near to the hunter and when the dog makes contact, it will point the bird. The hunter moves hastily towards the dog and on a given signal from the guide the dog will flush the bird who will try to escape. Once the bird takes to the wings the hunter can make the shot.

*T*his hunting form is very exciting and filled with action. The hunt is performed in mixed biotope; old and young forest, in the border zone between moors and forest.

*W*e only use fully trained dogs and we train them year round to ensure the quality of the hunt. Remember that this hunt can sometimes be physical demanding since it is important to move quickly when the dog points. We normally hunt all day with breaks for coffee and a longer break for lunch and rest in the forest or at the camp.

*S*eaSon: Aug 25th - Oct 10th

*P*rice example for 2-4 hunters: Euro 1 890.- per person

*L*enght: 1 week (5 hunting days)

*T*he price includes:

- Maximum 3 capercaillies (2 male, 1 female) 10 black grouses (9 male, 1 female) per hunter for 5 hunting days.
- Local hunting guide (English speaking), max 3 guests per guide
- Accommodation at Camp Nordic Footprints
- Full board with 3 meals per day and soft drinks
- Arrival day before the hunt and departure day after the hunt
- Hunting fees & hunting insurance
- Transport on hunting ground
- Free shooting for fox, mountain hare and pine marten.
- Certificate that the birds were legally hunted in Sweden.
- Prices include taxes

*N*ot included:

- Hunting weapon (or documentation and fees for import of weapon)
- Transport to/from Sweden
- Transfer from airport or train station
- Clothing and other personal equipment
- Hunting guide with dog
